



Diploma das Ilhas Açoreanas (Azorean Islands Diploma)



This award is sponsored by the “**Associação de Radioamadores dos Açores**”, and is opened to all Amateur radio/SWL worldwide that presents proofs of contacts/SWL, with Azorean stations, and its valid from **One of January 1986**.

This award is categorized in **two** different **classes**, in accordance with the number of contacts and location of each Amateur Radio/SWL, proposing himself to the award, as follows:

“Diploma das Ilhas Açoreanas”, 1st Class

It is conferred to the Amateur Radio/SWL the “Diploma das Ilhas Açoreanas” 1st Class, who presents proofs of contacts/SWL, **all mode, all band**, with a minimum of five different Islands of the Azores Archipelago including, **obligatorily**, the Island of São Miguel (CU2), as follows:

Location	Number of Contacts
Portugal (Açores and Madeira) Spain	Minimum of Sixteen (16) contacts/SWL with Azorean stations including Five (5) different Islands, being one, the Island of São Miguel (CU2), obligatorily.
Europe America (North, Central and South)	Minimum of Twelve (12) contacts/SWL with Azorean stations including Five (5) different Islands, being one, the Island of São Miguel (CU2), obligatorily.
Africa Asia Oceania	Minimum of Eight (8) contacts/SWL with Azorean stations including Five (5) different Islands, being one, the Island of São Miguel (CU2), obligatorily.

Diploma das Ilhas Açoreanas, 2nd Class

It is conferred to the Amateur Radio/SWL the “Diploma das Ilhas Açoreanas” 2nd Class, who presents proofs of contacts/SWL, **all mode, all band** with a minimum of five different Islands of the Azores Archipelago including, **obligatorily**, the Island of São Miguel (CU2), as follows:

Localization	Number of Contact
Portugal (Açores and Madeira) Spain	Minimum of Eight (8) contacts/SWL with Azorean stations including Five (5) different Islands, being one, the Island of São Miguel (CU2), obligatorily.
Europe America (North, Central office and South)	Minimum of Six (6) contacts/SWL with Azorean stations including Five (5) different Islands, being one, the Island of São Miguel (CU2), obligatorily.
Africa Asia Oceania	Minimum of Five (5) contacts/SWL with Azorean stations including Five (5) different Islands, being one, the Island of São Miguel (CU2), obligatorily.

The contacts can be made in **all mode and all band** in accordance with the band plans of IARU for each respective region.
